

Big Horn Loop Drive

I think our Absaroka Region probably has the best accessible drives of all our zones. In a one-day drive, we can see all the geographic interests that make our region special. One of these drives is the Bighorn Loop. We started in the morning and went from Billings to Greybull, WY, where we had lunch at one of our favorite places, Lisa's Western Cuisine. In that portion of the drive we faced the Beartooth Mountains at one point, drove along the Pryor Mountains, and down into Wyoming, we were along the Big Horns. Driving from Lovell to Greybull is a lovely stretch of straight road through the high desert. Coming down into Greybull, I find that it's a little unexpected oasis with the Bighorn River. The path we take from Greybull leads to Shell, Wyoming and up into the Bighorn Mountains via US Hwy 14.



A nice stop after a little climb is the Shell Falls Interpretive Site, where you can see the awesome power of water carving a massive amount of stone away to create a magnificent waterfall. After cooling off there in the mist, we continue on to Burgess Junction where you can continue over the mountains to Dayton or cut back toward Lovell on ALT 14. Both these roads show some spectacular scenery and rock formations.

If you're adventurous enough, you can hike a bit to the Medicine Wheel on top of Medicine Mountain (but bring your oxygen!) and then the descent back into Lovell, if timed right, has a most wonderful sunset over the Beartooth Mountain Range and the Bighorn Reservoir.

All in all I think this drive is the one that showcases the beauty of our region best. If you haven't gone on this drive with us, I encourage you to try it: go at a leisurely pace and enjoy all there is to see.

Other winners were a Jaguar, Austin Healy and a Porsche Cayman.










